Moments for Lebanon is an artistic and humanitarian initiative based in Paris, founded by a collective of Lebanese women, to bring people together through art, and community in support of Lebanon.

The project takes the form of a curated exhibition and artistic event that happens over 4 days in a special location in Paris, with the ambition of raising funds to provide urgent relief in the country. More than an Art sale, it is both a platform for creative expression and a collective act of solidarity that aims in transforming shared moments into tangible impact for Lebanon.

Our first edition of *Moments for Lebanon* in November 2024 brought together a curated selection of works by both established and emerging artists. From photography to illustrations, and paintings, the event welcomed over 1,000 international visitors over a two-day period and raised € 73,000 in profit. The entire profit was donated to four non-profit, non-governmental organizations in Lebanon:

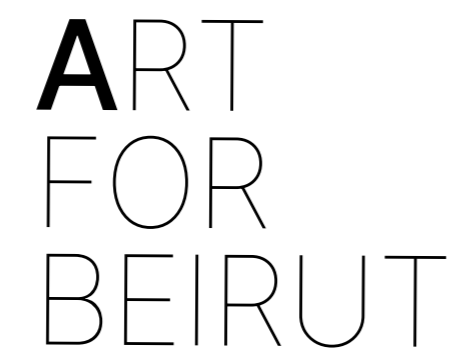

AFB organized a charity auction of art, jewelry and fashion pieces, in collaboration with Sotheby's London to support relief efforts in Beirut following the blast, raising over \$390,000.

Exhibition theme

Titled *Fragments of Memorabilia*, our second edition explores how memory, identity, and home are shaped through the fragments we carry — across places, cultures, and time.

Memorabilia are not only objects, they are vessels of memory holding traces of where we come from: a place, a culture, a language, a scent, a texture, a feeling.

For many, particularly diasporic communities, home is not singular or fixed. It is layered, shifting, and often reconstructed through memory. It can exist in a remembered space, a material fragment, a scent, a sound, a ritual, or something abstract, distant, or imagined.

Through fragmentation, we acknowledge that home is often experienced in pieces; collected over time, carried across geographies, and reassembled into identity.

Art and Performances

The exhibition will showcase a curated selection of over 140 works by more than 90 artists from around the world—both established and emerging—brought together in support of Lebanon. The artworks presented include both existing pieces and works created specifically for the occasion, reflecting a diversity of practices.

At the heart of the exhibition is “**Fragments**” — a collective installation composed of over 100 small-scale artworks (approximately 20x20 cm), assembled into a single wall-based composition. In addition, a selection of larger works will be available for purchase.

The exhibition will extend beyond the visual arts through a series of live events, including musical performances, and more. For more information on the programming, we invite you to stay connected through our social channels.

Following the event, the catalogue will be made available online for a further two months, during which the artworks will remain available for purchase.

Moments x Galerie Au Roi

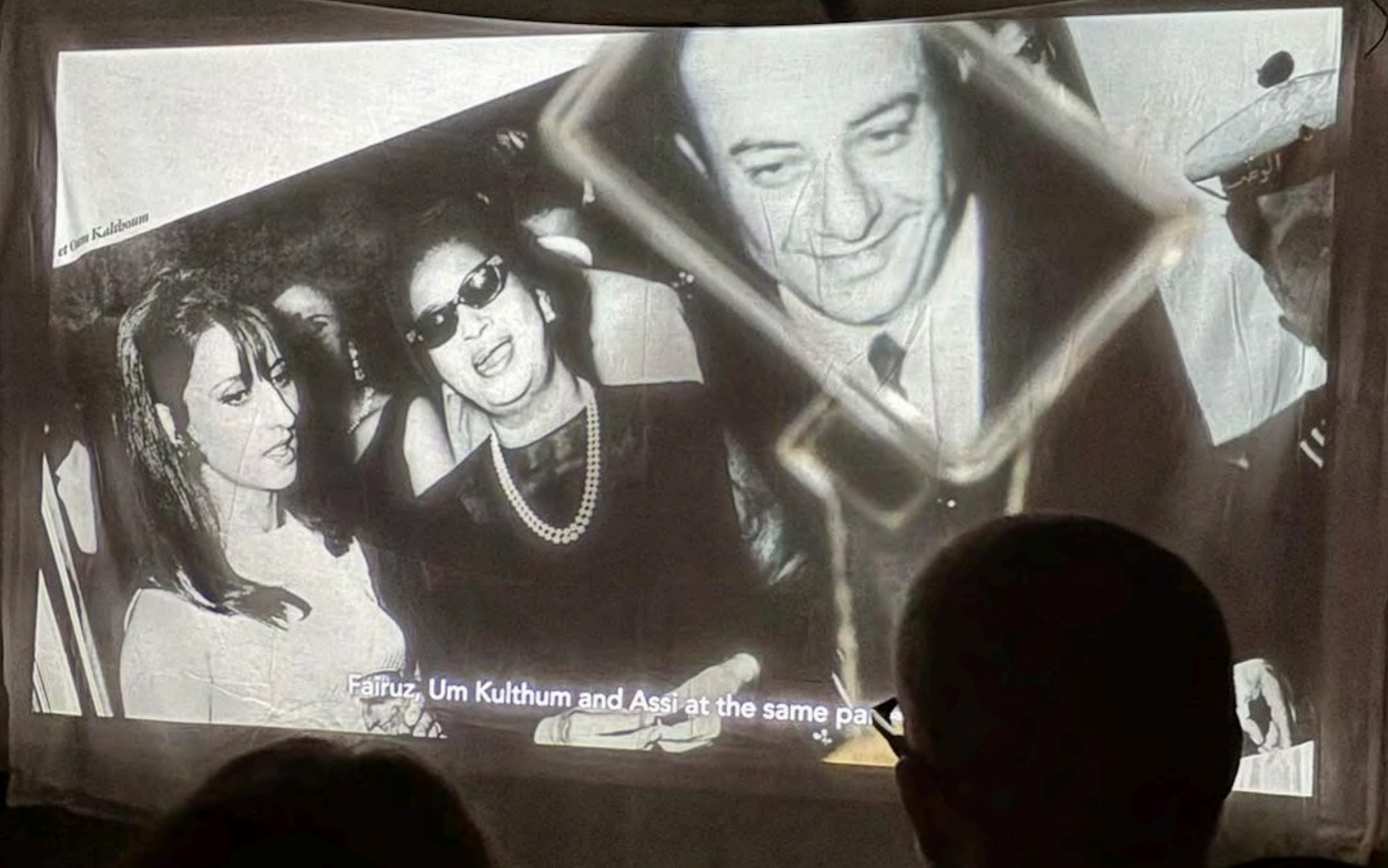

Funds raised will be donated to arcenciel, Lebanese Red Cross, Beit El Baraka, Offrejoie

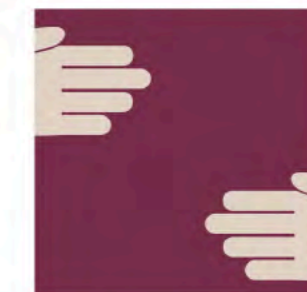
